MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: COMBAT VETERANS MOTORCYCLE ASSOCIATION (CVMA®) POLICY ON LIFE MEMBERSHIP

1. IAW CVMA By-Laws, Article 3, Section 1. a) 8., b) 6., c) 10., any member may apply for Life Membership.
2. Must meet requirements of respective member category (Full, Supporter, and Auxiliary).
 - From date of application, preceding three (3) twelve (12) month increments active in the CVMA, the applicant shall:
 - Maintain consecutive membership in good standing during entire preceding 36-month period.
 - For each twelve (12) month period, a member must attend at least one sanctioned event.
 - Full and Supporter Members must attend National Meeting during one of the three (3) twelve (12) month periods.
 - Auxiliary Members must attend National Auxiliary meeting during one of the three (3) twelve (12) month periods.
 - No waivers accepted.
3. Cost for Life membership is ten (10) years of current National dues.
4. Auxiliary Member's sponsor must already be a Life Member (or concurrently seeking Life Member status).
5. Only qualifying Sanctioned events that have been posted to the members 201 file will be accepted. All events must have been posted within six (6) months from event.
6. If a Full or Supporter life member leaves the Association for any reason, no refunds will be made.

7. If an Auxiliary Life Member leaves the Association for any reason, including loss of Sponsorship, no refunds will be made.
 8. Death of the sponsor is not considered a loss of Sponsorship.
9. Member(s) that have left the Association and returned as a new member, must re-apply and meet the requirements with their new member number.
10. Responsibilities.
 - a) It is the responsibility of the State and Chapter officers to ensure members are aware of the requirements for Life Membership. To accurately and timely record member participation at CVMA events in the individual 201 files.
 - b) It is the responsibility of the members to participate in CVMA events to show they are active members in the Association and to ensure their participation is accurately reflected in their 201 files.
