CVMA® POLICY 8-1-12

Effective date: August 14, 2012

SUBJECT: SANCTIONING EVENTS

1. State Representatives have the authority to sanction events/runs within their respective states. The following requirements are to be followed before sanctioning any event.
 - a. The event is coordinated and run by a chapter of the CVMA to benefit those serving on active duty, a Veteran or Veteran's charity.
 - b. If not run by the CVMA, the event is to honor those that have served or are currently serving our country and likewise benefits those serving on active duty, a Veteran or Veteran's charity.
 - c. The event will show the CVMA in a positive and productive role as a National Veterans Association and enhance our image within the community.
 - d. Always keep in mind sanctioning too many events degrades the value of the term itself. Use your good judgment.
2. Funerals, funeral escorts, honor flights, and memorial preparations should not be sanctioned as they are events that we should be honored to participate in.
3. POC for this policy is the National Sergeant at Arms (NSAA).
