CVMA Policy 8-1-13 (Revision C)

MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: COMBAT VETERANS MOTORCYCLE ASSOCIATION (CVMA) POLICY ON VOTING

1. In Accordance With (IAW) CVMA By-Law, Article 3: Full Members in good standing in the CVMA shall be eligible to vote. Support Members may vote in Chapter business if allowed by individual Chapter Bylaws. Medically retired, Auxiliary members are not allowed to vote on any CVMA business.
2. All voting for officers and By-Law amendments requires the member casting the vote to be physically present at the time and location where the vote is taken, i.e. Chapter, State, Region, or National meeting.
3. IAW CVMA By-Law, Article 10: Chapters may allow deployed military members to vote for chapter officers via e-mail directly to the secretary provided such is included in the chapter bylaws.
4. Officers will ensure that only eligible members are allowed to vote.
5. No proxy, email or absentee casting of votes is allowed, except for those outlined in section 3 above.
6. The POC for this policy is the NVP.
